(WGST) Wednesday marks the 150th anniversary of Georgia's secession from the Union, and the Georgia Historical Society is marking the event with a new program to install historical markers telling the lesser known stories of the Civil War.

Doctor Todd Groce is unveiling a new marker in Millidgeville Wednesday that describes the January 19, 1861 decision for the state to leave the union.

"This is one of 13 new historical markers the Georgia Historical Society is putting up across the state,"

said Groce.

The Historical Society has set up a website where people can pinpoint the locations of the new historical markers.
